Minister of State for Co-operation Manish Grover on Friday said, "The dues are for the current season. There is no outstanding amount for the previous years." Panipat MC collects₹23-lakh licence fee from 139 traders

PANIPAT, FEBRUARY 22

The Panipat Municipal Corporation has collected only Rs 23.80 lakh as licence fee from 139 traders owing to its failure to conducted a survey of commercial activities in the city.

The corporation had fixed licence fee ranging from Rs 1,000 to Rs 10,000 for various categories over two years ago. Sources said the MC was facing financial crisis and the authorities did not have funds to pay to their contractors. The MC had sought an additional budget of Rs 62 crore from the Directorate, Urban Local Bodies, to undertake development works. However, it failed to raise sources of income of the corporation.

Panipat is considered to be the commercial city in the state with more than 40,000 shopkeepers, traders, and factory owners. However, only 139 traders had obtained licence from the MC so far, the sources said.

An official said, "No survey on commercial activities in the city has been conducted by the MC or the government so far." Anil Madaan, president of the Sanyukt Vyapaar Mandal (SVM), said 42 city markets were registered under the mandal

When contacted, MC Commissioner Veena Hooda admitted that the MC was facing financial crisis. The Commissioner said the authorities had been trying to increase income sources. She said the trade licence system was started nearly two years ago, but it was not implemented properly. "I will chalk out new plans to increase the MC revenue," she said. — TNS



The zero hour saw members raise the issue of disparity in land acquisition awards vociferously. Various legislators from the Opposition benches pointed out that compensation in adjoining villages differed causing resentment among the people. Revenue Minister Capt Abhimanyu said the disparity arose because of the difference in collector rate of the districts. The members said that there was a need for rationalising the policy.

gress Legislature Party leader Kiran Choudhry was not present in the House on both days. Kuldeep Bishnoi and Renuka Bishnoi, too, have not been present since the House began. Congress MLA Randeep Singh Surjewala, after his appearance on the day the session began, has been absent.

Yesterday, after missing his question due to his late arrival, Congress MLA Karan

Dalal blamed the traffic bottleneck at the entry and claimed that at the Assembly parking, there was little space for legislators.

Meanwhile, during the question hour, Agriculture Minister OP Dhankar, in reply to a question raised by INLD MLA Ram Chand Kamboj, said that during 2017-18, a premium of Rs 208.98 crore had been collected from the farmers under Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana, whereas Rs 849.73 crore was disbursed as compensation amount to farmers.

Dhankar said the compensation amount for the loss of cattle due to an unknown disease in some villages of Sirsa in 2017 had been sent to the office of DC.

Anil Vij said the Civil Hospital of Ambala city would be upgraded to 300-bedded hospital for which an administrative approval of Rs. 64.71 crore had been accorded.

Education Minister Ram Bilas Sharma said that during 2018-19, the government had distributed Rs106.39 crore as scholarship to the Scheduled Caste students of government schools from classes 1 to 12, and soon the remaining SC students would get it too. Urban Local Bodies Minister Kavita Jain said there was a proposal to install 210 additional tube wells to meet the shortage of water in Faridabad.
